Topic: Ordinal Numbers

1. Concept

The order of ordinal numbers are we add ‘st’ for numbers ending in 1 except for eleven, ‘nd’ for numbers ending in 2 except for twelve, and we add ‘rd’ for numbers ending in 3 except for thirteen. We add ‘th’ for numbers 4 to 9, and numbers divisible by 10.

2. Objectives

2.1 Terminal Objectives

The learners should be able to discriminate ordinal numbers and identify their spelled-out words.

4.2.3 The learners are then tasked to compare 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th. They will be asked to identify their similarities.

4.2.4 The learners will now form the theories and compare it from the ordinal numbers of 11 to 20.

The learners will answer the part of their worksheet to complete the order of numbers.
